SAFETY AT BROOKWOOD SCHOOL

Drop Off & Pick Up Safety Measures:

- Parents/Guardians bringing students to school and picking them up are asked to wait outside of the school.
- Supervision Reminders:
 - In the mornings Supervision begins at 8:15.
 - We look forward to welcoming students at that time.
 - Dismissal is at 3:05 Supervision ends at 3:15.
- For safety reasons, please do not bring your dogs on school property.



Parents and Visitors

- Reminder all parents and visitors are required to enter through the front entrance of the school and check in at the office.
- Parents/Guardians who bring items for their children will be requested to leave it in the office, and we will get it to their child.
- Parents & Guardians please wait outside the designated doors to meet your children at the end of the day.

Volunteers for In Class and Off-Site Field Trips

- Volunteers are required to submit a "Volunteer Registration Form" at least 48 hours prior to their actual volunteer service.
- Volunteers are required to have a "Criminal Record Check" if they are volunteering for more than ten hours per year.
- Volunteers are required to have a "Criminal Record Check" if they are going "off-site" with students.


