Total funds of \$106,844 plus \$8,045 in unmatched transactions = \$114,889

## 5. Read-A-Thon Update

- Total of 150 students donated money, 180 students read raising a total of \$18,100 gross revenue and \$16,565 net profit.

- Some discussion for next year that perhaps the prizes are earned for any reading completed to encourage more readers

## 6. Brookwood Flag Update

- Flag is ready for pick up! The finalized version is a 12 foot double sided flag for ~\$570.

## 7. Brookwood School Wishlist

- Given the success of the read-a-thon, the association revisits the remaining wishlist items which includes:
